**ESC Training and Research Grants**

I am pleased to inform you that your application for an ESC Training Fellowship was successful. There were 45 applications in total and twelve Training and Research Fellowships have been awarded.

As you know the purpose of the Training Fellowships is to provide an opportunity for clinical training in cardiology in an ESC member country, other than your own, having completed a major part of your cardiology training but before obtaining a permanent post.

A grant of Euros 25,000 is provided for each one year Fellowship and is paid to your host academic institution. The Head of Department and Administrative Officer of this institution will be informed.

Your award will be announced by Professor Michel Komajda, ESC President, at the Opening Ceremony of the Munich Congress on Saturday August 25th. You are invited to attend and will receive free registration to the Congress although you will have to meet your own travel and accommodation costs. Would you please provide an electronic picture of your face only for his official slide presentation. At the end of the ceremony you are invited to join Professor Komajda for a formal photograph with the other Fellows.

You can now contact your supervisor at the host academic institution to make all the practical arrangements to take up your Fellowship.
